A special note to our visitors: We practice "Close(d) Communion" like the ancient Christian church of the first four centuries, and like the confessional Lutheran churches since the Reformation. The Lord's Supper requires understanding and faith in order for the communicant to receive its blessing and not bring judgment upon himself (I Cor. 11:27 ff.).



Therefore, in loving concern for those visitors, who are not members of the CLC (Church of the Lutheran Confession), we limit participation in the Supper. If you are looking for an altar at which to commune, please speak with the pastor after the service. Our practice is not a judgment of anyone's faith, but a confession of our own before God and before the world.

Alone, O Christ, You only are the Lord At God's right hand in majesty most high: Who with the Spirit worshiped and adored, With all the heav'nly host we glorify.


PRAYER OF THE DAY
